An additional messenger is added for each additional \$400 contribution to the General Fund up to a maximum of seven (7) messengers for any church.

News From The CWE by Carla Calhoun




Our preschoolers were so excited to sing the song "Praise Ye the Lord" to everyone at chapel on Thursday morning. We hope to learn a new one for April.
