

Our kids certainly know that we are not perfect, just forgiven.



A few weeks ago, I had the opportunity to visit Puerto Rico and invest time with the National Team Leader, Matt. He is a new leader, but much more organized than I am. There are some big challenges that he is facing, and we are trusting God together for His direction.



During part of the visit, the plan was for me to go on campus at one of the universities and meet some of the students. There was a strike, though, so the campus was closed. I did get to meet with a couple of the campus staff, pictured here.



This week I am headed to Cuba and will be there from April 27th to May 1st. Please pray that God will use the time for His glory and purposes, for protection for me and for the family back home during the trip, as well as for favor in the eyes of the customs agents. Our National Team Leader has requested some materials that I will be bringing in addition to cash for a teacher conference, so the hope is that there will be no issues bringing those things into the country.


