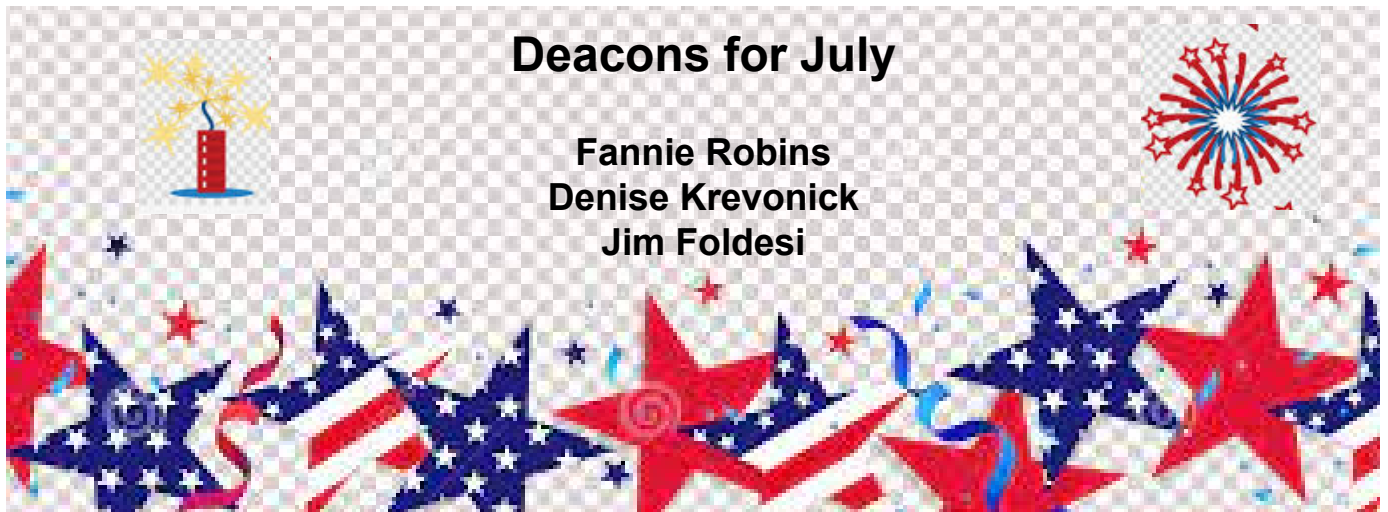

News from FMC WMU

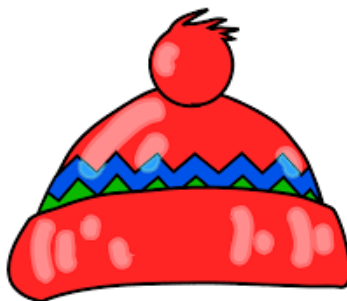
Your WMU ladies continue to work on many projects to spread the word of the Lord. We look to you for your love and support.
