## Fall Bible Study Series Four Views of the End Times

**Beginning October 1** we will begin a study on the four views of the end times. The Four Views of the End Times Bible Study is a fantastic 6-session Bible study that explains the 4 major ways Christians over the centuries have viewed Book of Revelation and the end times.

What does the Bible say about the end times that lead to the return of Jesus Christ? The differing ideas that divide believers into four major points-of-view are examined in the Four Views of the End Times small group study. This six-session study looks at:

- Four different Revelation timelines
- Dispensational Premillennialism, Postmillennialism, Historic Premillennialism, and Amillennialism
- Definitions, supporting Scriptures, notable Christian leaders

What Does this End-Times Bible Study Cover?

People want to know: What does the Bible actually say about the end times that lead to the return of Jesus Christ? The differing ideas that divide believers into four major points-of-view are examined in this Four Views of the End Times Bible Study. This Bible study tackles the four most popular eschatological views. It describes each end-times view objectively.

- 2. What do Christians Agree upon When It Comes to the End of the World?
- 3. Amillennialism
- 4. Dispensational Premillennialism

Main-stream media also use "manipulative rhetoric" to sway public opinion one way or the other.

So, the bottom line is don't believe everything you see or hear without first looking into it and doing some research. If it sounds too good to be true, then it probably isn't. We must do our homework in selecting candidates for whom to vote. As Christians we should vote our conscience according to biblical principles.
